AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF A MARSHALL AND CREATING A POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE VILLAGE OF _____ ; SETTING THE NUMBER OF OFFICERS AND PATROLMAN AND FIXING THEIR HOURS OF DUTY AND SETTING THEIR COMPENSATION.

WHEREAS, Section 80.240 RSMo. authorizes, the Board of Trustees to appoint a town marshal who shall be the chief of police.

WHEREAS, Section 80.240 RSMo. authorizes, the Board of Trustees to appoint other such officers as the Board deems to be necessary;

WHEREAS, Section 80.240 RSMo authorizes the Board of Trustees to prescribe the duties and fix the salary of all Village officers and employees;

WHEREAS, Sections 80.400 RSMo - 80.420 RSMo. establishes the organization for village police;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF _____, MISSOURI.

Section 1. There is hereby created a Police Department within the Village of _____, Missouri.

Section 2. The Police Department shall consist of a marshal who shall be the chief of police and _____ patrolmen.

Section 3. The work week of the marshal shall be _____ hours per week. The marshal's weekly work schedule shall be approved by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.

Section 4. The work week of each patrolman of the Police Department shall be _____ hours per week. The marshal shall prepare a work schedule for each patrolman, subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees.

Section 5. The compensation of the marshal shall be \$_____ per month, payable _____ (weekly, semi-monthly, monthly).

Section 6. The compensation of the patrolmen shall be set by the Board of Trustees within a range of \$ _____ to \$ _____ per month.

Section 7. The marshal shall be appointed and removed by the Board of Trustees.

Section 8. All patrolmen of the Police Department shall be appointed and removed by the Board of Trustees.

Section 9. The Board of Trustees shall promulgate such rules and regulations for the proper operation of the Police Department as shall be deemed necessary and not inconsistent with law.

Section 10. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
